<u>Notes to Net Control</u>: Be flexible and willing to *show your personality*. Also feel free to change the order of discussions (Fellowship, Technical, Announcements, etc). *Do not confront unruly users or interference on the air, if that happens ignore it and keep going.*

Remember, ALL the repeaters, Echolink, Allstar and links, have a 3 minute timeout, please keep transmissions to 2 minutes or less and then break, let the repeater drop for a minimum of 5 seconds, then continue for long transmissions.
